## TREASURER/FUNDRAISING — Suresh J

- Dues status everyone 100% up to date, except for new scouts. Do we pro-rate for transfer scouts? BSA fees only needed if they had a lapse in scouting. For troop dues, we don't pro-rate for cross-overs, in order to fund handbook and neckerchief. If others join later in the year, we will pro-rate troop dues and give them a list of required items (handbook, neckerchief, epaulets, shirt).

## Proposed addition to Troop Handbook Re: Youth Leadership Scholarship

- Purpose: To establish a perpetual scholarship fund to assist youth with registration fees for National Youth Leadership Training.
- Troop 918 will create a separate accounting line for the Youth Leadership Training Scholarship. This line will accommodate the expenditure of at least two (2) \$125 scholarships for NYLT. Current cost of NYLT is \$250 per person. If the cost of NLYT increase, the scholarship will increase to 50% of the registration cost.

The intention is that this line have at least \$250 in it at the beginning of each calendar year. Income for the fund may come from multiple sources:

- Donations from parents and/or interested parties
- A portion of excess funds from the troop general fund, as approved by the Troop Committee
- Fundraising activities, if necessary

For a youth to receive the scholarship funds, they must formally request assistance from the Troop Committee, DISCUSSING HOW THEY INTEND TO USE THIS TRAINING TO LEAD WITHIN THE TROOP, and subsequently must report back to the Troop Committee at the conclusion of the training activity that they have completed the training and share their experiences. The Scout will be expected to pay the full registration fee. At successful completion, the Scout will be reimbursed for 50% of that fee.

This scholarship can only be disestablished by a majority vote of the Troop Committee, at which point funds will be transferred to the troop general fund.

Additional suggestions:

- Add provision that the Scout must become a leader within the troop

Also –

- Removed term "hardship issues" as possibly embarrassing to Scout or parent.
- Removed entire sentence about providing funds up front will be handled as all other funding which can be provided up front based on need.
- Added approval by the troop committee for adding funds to this from the troop general fund
- Changed voting to disestablish to troop committee
