- ▶ If Scouts need a Scoutmaster Conference then the Scout/Parent should notify the Scoutmaster
- ▶ Once the Scoutmaster Conference is complete the Scoutmaster will let Mr. Dave know to schedule a Board of Review—the final step of Advancement.
